SAFETY DATA SHEET (SDS)

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I. IDENTIFICATION

Product Identity: EXPECTING (Peppermint, Lavender, Ginger, Lemon, Lime) Essential Oil Inhaler Inhalation Only

II. Hazards

Ingredients in the product are not known or classified as hazardous. The ingredients are proprietary therapeutic grade pure essential oils in vapor form only. Contains no other additives.

III. COMPOSITION

Contains the following substances provided as a passive, low ambient concentration vapor; Peppermint (Mentha piperita), Ginger (Zingiber officinale), Lavender (Lavandula angustifolia), Lemon, Lime)

IV. FIRST AID MEASURES

General: move to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, give O2. If not breathing, provide artificial respiration. Seek medical attention.

V. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing Media:

CO2, foam, or dry chemical

Unusual Fire and Explosion Hazards:

NONE; material is not pyrophoric, does not react with water, not oxygen donor, material is shock stable.

VI. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

No accidental release measures apply.

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VII. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Store in tightly sealed containers in cool dry area. Avoid exposing to temperatures above 35 degrees Celsius. Store out of direct sunlight; exposure to light accelerates decomposition. Stable under recommended storage conditions.

VIII. EXPOSURE CONTROLS/PERSONAL PROTECTION

This product is non-hazardous. No known health hazards with acute or chronic exposure. No personal protective measures required.

IX. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

Physical state: vapor

Odor: characteristic

Flash point: 154 degrees

X. STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

Hazardous polymerization will not occur. Stable under normal circumstances. No data available on hazardous reactions. Avoid excessive heat.

XI. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

No known acute or chronic toxicity hazard. No known carcinogen hazard.

XII. ECOLOGICAL INFORMATION

No known toxicity, persistence and degradability or bio accumulative potential.

XIII. DISPOSAL CONSIDERATIONS

No special handling required. Follow local, state and federal waste disposal laws.

At first sign of patient nausea:

- Open EXPECTING, hold near nose or mouth and instruct patient to take several deep breaths. May be used as often as necessary.
- EXPECTING may be used continuously. Place open EXPECTING near patient's airway, for continuous passive diffusion.
- Label EXPECTING with patient sticker.
- Place EXPECTING in patient's hand or other accessible location when discharging, to allow easy access in the event of motion related queasiness.
- Instruct patient to use as often as needed for post discharge nausea.

EXPECTING is intended for SINGLE PATIENT USE.
